



Dear SAINTS FAMILIES,

For more than 40 years Lutheran High School has provided an exceptional educational community for the students and families of Central Indiana. It is not a surprise that the Indiana Department of Education has recognized this value and awarded LHS maximum credit for its graduation rate and college prep curriculum. This value added can be seen as 100% of our students share in worship, Christian education, and community service; 97% pursue college education; 95% are involved in extracurricular activities; and over half of all seniors graduate with earned college credit while out-performing our neighboring schools on college entrance exams.

The cost of this education continues to rise. Next year the families of LHS will not see an increase in enrollment, course, or technology fees; but will see a \$400 increase in the 2018-2019 academic tuition. To help families with this cost we are happy to announce that our association of Lutheran churches will be able to increase their family member tuition discount to \$1000. Also, LHS is projecting to distribute over \$550 thousand to more than 80% of its families in the coming year.

This past fall, LHS dedicated a new track and field facility. This improvement opened up new opportunities to the physical education curriculum, the high school athletic teams, and the rising Junior Saint programs. These improvements are important in the programming and sustainability of our high school and are *not funded by tuition and fees*. Growth like this will continue as LHS focuses its attention on the students by preparing them for a Christian life while providing a community of academic excellence.

We thank God for the blessing and value of LHS. We look forward to the coming celebration of graduation and the opportunities of a new school year.

FEES

Enrollment Fee: The enrollment fee for all newly accepted and returning students is \$200. This fee holds a place for the student and allows the student to register for classes and apply for financial aid.

Take advantage of EARLY ENROLLMENT with the following early enrollment fees:

- If you enroll January 1-31, the enrollment fee is only \$100.
- If you enroll February 1-28, the enrollment fee is only \$150.
- If you enroll March 1, 2018 and later, the enrollment fee is the regular fee of \$200.

Course Fee (\$450): This fee includes all high school level classroom books (does not include college AP & college ACP books), e-books, e-Bible, laboratory materials and workbooks, PE uniform and digital access fee.

Senior Fee (\$100): This fee includes senior graduation gown and diploma costs.

Computer Fees: If you will be leasing an Apple MacBook Air, lease fee options include annual (\$495) or 12-month payment plans (\$41.25/month).

Fee Payment Policies

- Diplomas and/or transcript will not be released unless all financial obligations, including tuition, fees, and fines, have been paid.
 - Students who withdraw for any reason will be charged tuition through the semester in which they withdrew, and also will be charged all enrollment, course and senior fees.
 - Enrollment fees can be refunded, less \$50 in the event of an unexpected withdrawal up until July 1.
 - Course fee and senior fee are non-refundable after Saints Sign Up Day.
- AP & ACP book fees are non-refundable after the first five days of school.
