



# CHOICE SCHOLARSHIP (VOUCHER) APPLICATION PROCESS For Lutheran High School

*If your family meets one of the seven pathways to receive a Choice Scholarship (Voucher) in the list below AND meets the income qualifications in the table below, this is the process to sign up for a Choice Scholarship (Voucher) at Lutheran High School of Indianapolis (LHS).*

- \_\_\_ 1: Complete the student enrollment for Lutheran High School through ParentsWeb.
- \_\_\_ 2: Submit the family financial aid application through ParentsWeb>>FACTS>>Apply for Grant & Aid or at [online.factsmgmt.com/aid](http://online.factsmgmt.com/aid). We encourage you to begin the application process January 1, and then upload your 2016 tax information at a later date. There is a \$30 fee to FACTS for this process. The Priority Deadline is March 15, 2017. This confidential process completes your **income review for both the Choice Scholarship program and financial aid** through Lutheran High School.
- \_\_\_ 3: Complete the attached Lutheran High School *Choice Scholarship (Voucher) Applicant Information Form* (one for each student). Please remember to **sign the back of the form and return it to the LHS office** in person or by email to Beverly McIntosh at [bmcintosh@lhsi.org](mailto:bmcintosh@lhsi.org). Once all the paperwork is received and the State approves the application:
  - a) You will need to sign and return the final State approval letter.
  - b) You will receive a letter via email with your Choice Scholarship amount and/or financial aid amount that will need your signature before your payment plan can be adjusted.

### **Seven Pathways to Receive an Indiana Choice Scholarship (Voucher)**

- A. The student received a Choice Scholarship (Voucher) last year.
- B. The student received a Choice Scholarship (Voucher) in a different previous year.
- C. The student received an SGO Scholarship in any previous year.
- D. The student has an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or a service plan.
- E. The student would go to an “F” rated school if attended public school of record.
- F. The student attended the last two semesters in a public school.
- G. A sibling of the student received either a Choice Scholarship (Voucher) or an SGO Scholarship in any previous year.
