TUITION

Below are the tuition payment amounts based on the tuition plans offered. Installment amounts below are rounded to the nearest dollar. The actual charge may vary a few cents to reach exact tuition amounts. Please note that the amounts below do not reflect financial assistance that may be applied to your account.

FEES

Enrollment Fee: The enrollment fee for all newly accepted and returning students is \$200. This fee holds a place for the student and allows the student to register for classes.

Take advantage of EARLY ENROLLMENT with the following early enrollment fees:

- ▶ If you enroll January 1-31, the enrollment fee is only\$100.

▶ If you enroll March 1, 2017 and later, the enrollment fee is the regular fee of \$200.

(For newly accepted students, the \$30 application fee is applied to this enrollment fee.)

Course Fees: This fee includes all high school level classroom books, e-books, e-Bible, laboratory materials and workbooks, PE uniform, digital access fee, senior graduation gown and diploma.

Computer Fees: If you will be leasing an Apple MacBook Air, lease fee options include annual (\$495) or 12-month payment plans (\$41.25/month).

Fee Payment Policies

- · Tuition and fees must be current before a student's record will be transferred or credits issued.
- · If all tuition and fees from the preceding year are not paid, a student will not be re-enrolled.
- Seniors will not be granted a diploma and/or transcript unless all financial obligations, including tuition, fees, and fines, have been met by the time of graduation.
- Students who withdraw for any reason will be charged tuition through the semester in which they withdrew.
- Students who enter after the beginning of the semester pay current tuition and all fees.
- · Accounts delinquent beyond 30 days will be assessed a \$25 late fee.
