Focus on five (teachers)

- Discuss and prepare students for chapel. Encourage students to be attentive by sitting up and participating.
- Talk about being a positive fan. Cheer for our saints, don't negatively yell at opponents or officials, and always be courteous to visiting fans. This effort is important to our mission as a school.
- Midterm grades have been posted. Remind students of the importance in communicating with teachers. Teachers do want to help those who ask.
- Take a straw poll in your class to see how many students eat breakfast on a regular basis. Ask students to share what their breakfast consists of.
- Point students to our daily announcements if they are unsure how to find service hour opportunities. All students need 20 hours a year.

Focus on five (students)

- Keep track of your service hours. Each year you need to log in 20 service hours. You can find opportunities listed on daily announcements. Ask you religion teachers for help in understanding what counts as service hours.
