Focus on five (teachers)

- Discuss with students their entry into chapel. Students should be respectful of the environment by entering quietly and quickly settling into a seat with their class.
- Look at your second period student's Saints Walk pages. Encourage students to send personal emails to friends and family. A little from everyone goes a long way.
- Check that students are in saints wear. Point out examples of cold weather saints clothing. Students should take down hoods and take off hats when entering the building.
- Remind students that food is to be consumed in the commons only. Also encourage students to close food containers before moving in halls.
- Tell students that they are not allowed to use the food and candy vending machines during their class time or passing periods.

Focus on five (students)

- Please enter chapel with reverence by quietly taking seats and getting ready to worship. Be mindful that the cross is about to enter.
- SAINTS WALK is coming. Help your school by collecting sponsors for your walk. Email letters need to be sent out this week. Let's celebrate the reformation and let's celebrate Lutheran High School.
- The daytime temperatures are dropping. Put on more saints wear layers to stay warm in school. Please keep hoods down and hats off in the building.
- Keep in mind that open food containers are to stay in the commons. Close food containers and do not consume food in the halls or classrooms.
- Food and candy vending machines can be used before school, during lunch, or after school. Food and candy vending is off limits during class time and class time passing periods.
