Focus on five (teachers)

- Please remind students to actively show attention while in chapel. Sitting up, participating in prayer, song, and responsive reading is a good indicator of attentiveness. Remind students that they have a blessing that not all Indiana students get to engage in while at school. We thank the Lord for this blessing.
- We are close to our walking saints goal. Encourage students in the fact that we
 have one week left and to actively reach out to those who have not yet been
 asked to help in our effort.
- Check that students are in saints wear. Point out examples of cold weather saints clothing. Students should take down hoods and take off hats when entering the building.
- Remind students that food is to be consumed in the commons only. Also encourage students to close food containers before moving in halls.
- Talk about the importance of attendance in your room. Having all students in attendance every day is a strength for a classroom and school community.

Focus on five (students)

- Our chapel service is a unique blessing for a high school in Indianapolis. Let's get the most out of our worship time by engaging with attention and reverence.
- Thank you for the great Saints Walk. We are \$1500 from our goal and still have until next week to collect donations. We can do this together!
- The daytime temperatures are dropping. Put on more saints wear layers to stay warm in school. Please keep hoods down and hats off in the building.
- Keep in mind that open food containers are to stay in the commons. Close food containers and do not consume food in the halls or classrooms.
- School attendance does count. Missing days are recorded and can lead to problems in school credit. Thank you for making school attendance a priority.
