## Focus on five (teachers)

- Please remind students to actively show attention while in chapel. Sitting up, participating in prayer, song, and responsive reading is a good indicator of attentiveness.
- Encourage the young men in our school to take care of their personal space, namely the bathroom. Writing or scratching obscenities in the bathroom is not who we want to be or who HE wants us to be. Bathroom stalls are a "privilege", not a "right", they can go away.
- Talk about the great opportunity to recognize our veterans. Walking as Christ did does include the willingness to lay down your life to save another.
- Remind students that food is to be consumed in the commons only. Also encourage students to close food containers before moving in halls.
- Encourage students to be respec0ul of PDA in all school environments (classroom, halls, before and after school, parking lot, events).

## Focus on five (students)

- Please do not lay your head back or to the side during chapel. It sends a message of discontent and inattentiveness.
- Gentlemen, please take care of your bathroom. Discourage anyone from making your personal space a disgrace by defacing your privilege to have privacy. Let's make our community better.
- We thank and praise our Heavenly Father for leading us in the understanding of sacrificial giving. Our veterans give us all an example of true sacrifice to the point of laying down one's own life for others.
- Keep in mind that open food containers are to stay in the commons. Close food containers and do not consume food in the halls or classrooms.
- Please consider your public display of affection. Limit your intimate feelings toward another with handholding and hugs.
